The second of Carl Friedrich Julius Jaeger's three miniature atlases was published about the same time as his first one (see 1843). It measures about 100 x 120 mm. and contains thirteen maps too, but this time measuring about 105 x 80 mm. and relating to Europe:

*Europa; De Nederlanden; Spanje en Portugal; Frankrijk; Italie; Groot-Brittanje en Ierland; Zweden en Noorwegen; Denemarken en IJsland; Duitschland; Het Koninkrijk Pruisen; Het Keizerrijk Oostenrijk; Europisch Rusland en Polen; Europ: Turkijke en Griekenland.*

These maps were also lithographed with hand-colour and there was a later reissue by the publisher of his third pocket atlas (see 1856).
