At Middelburg in 1598, Barent Langenes published an account of Cornelis Houtman's 1595/7 voyage to the East: *Diarium nauticum itineris Batavorum in Indiam Orientalem*. He illustrated it with four of the plates from the *Map-treasury* series of Cornelis Claesz (see 1598a).

In the same year John Wolfe published an English translation by William Phillip of this publication, with close copies of the same four maps:

Wolfe's English edition of Jan Huygen van Linschoten's travels contains three miniatures engraved by William Rogers (see 1598b), but the engraver of these other four English copies published by John Wolfe is not known, though it may well have been Rogers too.
