
Thomas Jenner acquired the thirty-seven English county mileage table plates engraved by Jacob van Langeren (see 1635a). He then erased the original thumbnail maps and engraved new ones in their place. They were copied from the general map of England in John Speed's Theatre. These uncommon new maps are on twice the scale of the original ones and more detailed:


