



Three London editions of a textbook by Jan A. Komensky (1592-1670), the Czech champion of universal education, contain a series of sixteen numbered plates. The last two of these are unusual twin hemisphere miniatures about 135 x 65 mm: a map of the world and a companion celestial chart.
