

The German astronomer, Johann Leonhard Rost (1688-1727), was the author of a work after Johann Hevelius. It was illustrated with thirty-eight plates and the first twenty-four of these are diagrams and other illustrations to the text. The following fourteen plates, each about 84 x 160 mm., are numbered XXV-XXXVIII and are divided up to hold forty tiny charts of the constellations.
