

A small but very rare work, illustrated with miniature maps, was issued at an unknown date by Charles-Antoine Jombert (1712-1784), who was a Parisian publisher and bookseller. It contains twenty-six plates measuring about 180 x 110 mm., which feature a map about 110 x 90 mm. with the title and key adjacent.
