






Louis Denis' atlas of Paris in the *Géographie des dames* (see 1762a) seems to have inspired Jean Lattré to engrave and publish his own version with an attractive engraved title-page by Pierre Philippe Choffard. This tiny work, 110 x 60 mm., also has twenty five double page plates and is usually found with full hand-colour. There is a plain index map and twenty four numbered sectional plans with decorated borders about 85 x 95 mm.
