In addition to producing four miniature atlases which are scarce items today (see 1757,

1762a, 1764a & 1768), the cartographer, engraver and publisher Louis Denis was the author of a small road book of France. This work of 688 pages is in two volumes about 165 x 100 mm. in size.

They include a general folding map of France measuring  $207 \times 207$  mm. and 221 double-strip road maps measuring  $77 \times 133$  mm. The first volume contains eighty-nine road maps and the second volume has 132 of them, together with the folding map of France.
