A geography textbook written by John Richard Green and Alice Stopford Green was illustrated with some plain miniature maps including the following regional ones:

Northumbrian counties; Lancashire and Cheshire; Counties of the Severn basin; Counties of the trent basin; Yorkshire; Counties of the Wash; East Anglian counties; Counties of the Thames basin; Southern counties; South Western counties; Welsh counties.

The book also included some thematic maps and all of them were produced by Edward Stanford's famous cartographical firm, with the imprint: 'London. Stanford's Geogl. Estabt.' Other miniatures by Stanford include some river maps (see 1873) and English and Welsh counties (see 1881a).
