Thomas Nelson

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A paperback Bible atlas issued by Thomas Nelson & Sons sold for sixpence about 1880. The front cover was also the title-page and the rear had a list of the maps. There were sixteen of these, about 125 x 80 mm., all numbered and in printed colour, with some having the publisher's imprint:

*The Ancient world shewing the distribution of nations after the flood; Canaan in the patriarchal ages; Journeying of the Israelites from Egypt to Canaan; Canaan as divided among the tribes; The Dominions of David and Solomon; The Kingdoms of Judah and Israel; Countries adjoining Canaan illustrating the captivities of the Jews; Persian Empire in its greatest extent; Mount Lebanon and Syria; Palestine illustrating the New Testament; The Roman Empire under Augustus; Palestine illustrating the journeys of Christ; The Sea of Galilee and environs of Nazareth; Map illustrating the journeys of St. Paul; Jerusalem; Environs of Jerusalem.*
