

Frank Roehr, printer, publisher and engraver, of Randolph Street in Chicago, issued trade cards with state maps on them for \$4 per thousand. The Missouri map was signed 'A.M. Askevold, Engraver'. Exactly when they first appeared is not known but Roehr did publish a map of Chicago in 1881. The cards measure about 140 x 85 mm. with the maps a little less, and a sample set cost ten cents. The titles commence *Map of*:

The United States; Illinois; Iowa; Wisconsin; Missouri; Michigan; Ohio; Minnesota; Indiana; Texas; Louisiana; Colorado; Nebraska; Kansas; New York; Pennsylvania; California; Nevada; Massachusetts; Maryland; Maine; Washington Terr.; Oregon; Dakota.
