A pocket atlas, 170 x 105 mm., was published by Moffatt & Paige of London about 1882. Its paper covers, with the title, contents list and imprint all printed on the front, contain twenty-four uncoloured numbered plates. These include nineteen maps about 90 x 120 mm. with the imprint of Moffatt & Paige at the foot, with some\* having several insets, hence the number 55 in the subtitle:

Map of geographical terms; Map of the World; England & Wales physical map; England & Wales political map; England & Wales railway map; Scotland; Ireland; Europe physical map; Europe political map; General index to British possessions; South Africa\*; Indian Empire\*; New Zealand\*; Australia; Canada\*; Asia; Africa; North America; South America.

A later issue, also undated, had new and improved versions of these same maps. The conjectural dating is based on the accession dates of copies in the British Library.
