A nicely done pocket atlas of the United States was published twice in Philadelphia. It had 244 pages lithographically printed and on the rectos of pages 5-101 are 'separate copper-plate maps of each state and territory, with all the railroads correctly shown.' The rest of the pages are of thinner paper and have population tables and lists of all the cities, towns and villages with populations from the 1880 census. These forty-nine maps are about  $80 \times 123$  mm. and all printed in pink with the seas coloured green:
