

A pocket atlas of Mexico, in limp covers measuring 100 x 160 mm., was published in Boston for Edgard Boulingny. A general map of Mexico is followed by ones of the individual states in alphabetical order and longitudes are given for Mexico at the head, but Greenwich at the foot. The last two maps are of railways, together with railway timetables. They are all single-page and unnumbered, with interesting advertisements on the rear. In total there are thirty-two chromolithographic maps about 133 x 82 mm:
