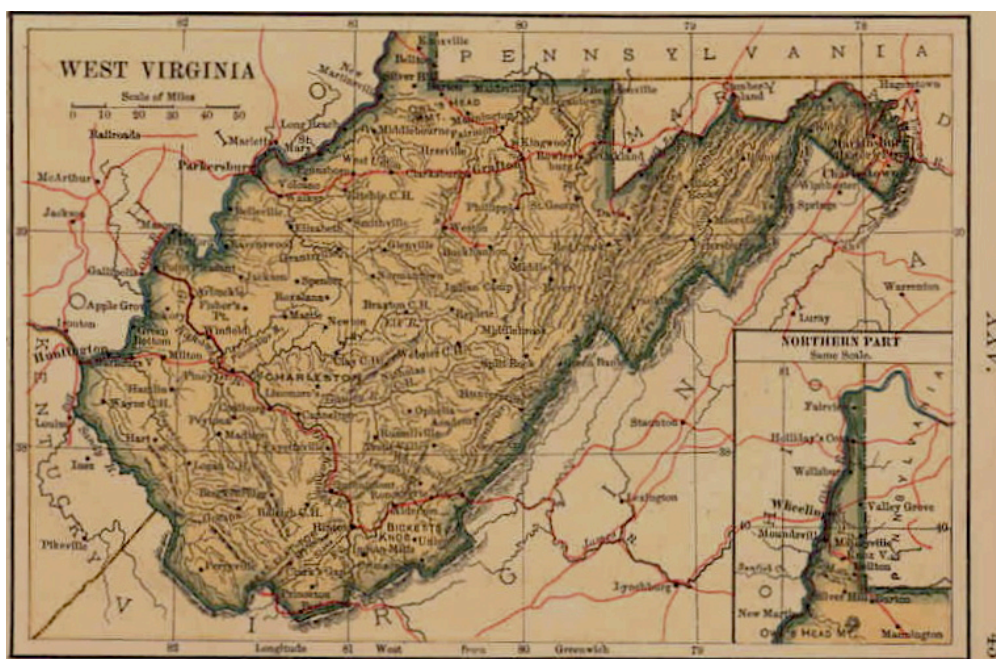


1887a Samuel Mecutchen & Henry D. Harrower

A rather nice quality pocket world atlas was put on sale in the U.S.A. in 1887 by the publishing firm of Ivison, Blakeman & Co. It contains no information on its author but, according to the Library of Congress, it was the work of Samuel Mecutchen and Henry Draper Harrower. The title-page has a copyright date of 1887 and a publisher's note on the back dated March 1, 1887. The atlas has embossed maroon soft covers with rounded corners and measures 155 x 110 mm. A later issue has additional pages with the results of the eleventh census of the United States, 1890.



This work consists of 224 pages lithographically printed, including ninety-one numbered coloured maps. All are single-page miniatures 84/5 x 126/7 mm., except for five* double-page ones:
