A California handbook was issued by the Elliott Publishing Company of San Francisco about 1892. Its price by mail was fifty cents. Within its printed soft covers measuring about 230 x 115 mm., are contained ninety-six stapled pages with 'a separate map of every county in colors, and an accurate description of every county.' A contents list and index are printed inside the rear cover.



The miniature maps of all the fifty-four counties of 1892 are printed within the text along with some others. They have the imprint of the Elliott Publishing Company and their titles commence with *Map of*:
